**Footnotes**

LIT'SGOODLOOKNGRAY angled in and stalked the pace inside, bid along the rail on the turn and into the stretch, put a head in front past the eighth pole and inched away late under urging. SPOILS OF EXCESS prompted the pace outside a rival then three deep on the turn and into the stretch, fought back to deep stretch and gamely took the place. SPOT THE DIPLOMAT stalked off the rail then between horses, continued outside on the turn and four wide into the stretch and edged a rival late for third. VICE ADMIRAL in a good position stalking the pace inside on the backstretch and turn, remained along the rail and was edged for the show. LUIS'S ESPECIAL had good early speed and dueled off the rail then between horses on the turn and in the stretch, weakened some late and was edged nearing the wire for a minor award. QUINTON'S FLEET stalked outside then five wide into the turn, came four wide into the stretch and lacked a further response. HONORED IMAGE unhurried off the rail on the backstretch, angled in outside a rival on the turn, drifted to the inside in the stretch and failed to menace. LAW BREAKER stalked between horses then four wide into the turn, continued off the inside and weakened. LUCKY THIRTEEN settled off the rail, angled in on the turn, came out in the stretch and was not a factor.
