ZAPPA stalked the runner-up a bit off the rail, came out some in the stretch, rallied to the lead under urging a sixteenth out and proved best. WELL ARMED pulled his way to the early lead and angled in, set the pace inside, came off the rail into the stretch, held on well to deep stretch but could not match the winner while saving the place. HEATSEEKER (IRE) pulled his way along and steadied in tight on the first turn, stalked the pace along the rail, remained inside in the stretch and bested the others. THOUSAND WORDS (GB) stalked inside then a bit off the rail, went between horses into and on the second turn, came out in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. RACKETEER chased outside a rival, came out three deep leaving the second turn and four wide into the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. ARSON SQUAD stalked outside a rival then three deep on the second turn and into the stretch and weakened. MOLENGAO (BRZ) settled a bit off the rail, came out on the second turn and five wide into the stretch and was not a threat.
