MIDNIGHT TRANSFER chased outside a rival, went four wide leaving the turn and into the stretch to gain the lead, inched away past midstretch and proved best under energetic handling. GLADDING stalked off the rail, bid three deep between horses into the stretch, battled inside the winner in midstretch, could not match that one but was clearly second best. CASTLETOWN had speed off the rail then dueled three deep, battled outside a rival on the turn and a bit off the rail into the stretch and just held third. MCKENZIES WAY broke a bit slowly, lagged back inside, came out into the stretch and in upper stretch and just missed the show. CHILOQUIN dueled between horses then inside leaving the turn and weakened in the stretch. CYCLOMETER chased a bit off the rail, came out on the turn, swung out into the stretch and lacked a rally. CHAPMAN'S PEAK went up inside to duel for the lead, stalked on the turn, dropped back and came out into the stretch and weakened.
