**Footnotes**

TIZNOW close up four wide early then three deep into the first turn, prompted the pace outside WOODEN PHONE, continued three deep leaving the second turn and into the stretch, brushed with that one in midstretch, gained a short lead past midstretch and gamely prevailed under a couple taps of the whip and steady handling. WALKSLIKEADUCK pulled along the inside early, had a rail trip, slipped through inside on the second turn, put a head in front into the stretch, inched away, fought back through the final furlong but could not quite match the winner late. WOODEN PHONE took the early lead and angled in, set a pressured pace a bit off the rail, battled between horses leaving the second turn and into the stretch, brushed with the winner nearing midstretch and continued willingly but was outfinished. NEW ADVANTAGE stalked the pace outside a rival to the second turn, continued a bit off the rail, came out late but lacked the needed response. NURDLINGER broke slowly and awkwardly, raced along the inside throughout and made up some ground but was not a threat. REMEMBER SHEIKH allowed to settle off the rail, remained out from the fence and weakened.
