ARMY OFFICER sped to the early lead off the rail, dueled outside a rival, put a head back in front into the stretch and pulled clear in the final furlong under

urging. LOOKS GREAT (BRZ) went up inside to duel for the lead, fought back on the turn and to midstretch and was second best. GOLADA KING wide between foes early, stalked outside, came three deep into the stretch and bested the others. MOST DECORATED a bit slow to begin, chased inside, split rivals into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. KNOBLOCK chased between foes then inside, came out on the turn and five wide into the stretch and improved position. A. C.'S MIRACLE chased outside or off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and did not rally. HANDSOME BILL broke slowly, settled a bit off the rail then inside on the turn, came out into the stretch and improved position but was not a threat. UMBER pulled his way between horses chasing the pace, continued outside on the turn and three deep into the stretch and could not offer the needed response. RINGMASTER saved ground on the turn, came out into the stretch and weakened. WHATSAMILLION pulled his way along to stalk a bit off the rail then inside, had the rider lose the whip on the turn and weakened. CHEWY CARMELLO settled outside then off the rail, came four wide into the stretch and failed to menace. STREET NUMBER bobbed slightly at the start, chased between horses and was not a factor. RED NECK BILL also bobbed slightly at the start, had brief speed between foes, dropped back on the backstretch and turn and gave way. LIGHTNING FELLOW broke a bit slowly, trailed off the rail and was always outrun.
