CELESTIC NIGHT unhurried from the inside, remained along the rail down the hill, roused entering the lane, found clear path, angled out then quickly reeled in leader and powered away. METROPOLITAN MAN quickly sprinted to the front and grabbed huge lead, retained clear cushion into the stretch, had lead evaporate in the drive then was overtaken passing sixteenth marker before holding second. DIAMOND GEEZAH (IRE) outside winner chasing the pace, continued on same path to dirt portion, came out some entering the lane, shifted back in and gained third. WEALTHY AVIATOR tracked the pacesetter from along the rail down the hill, came out crossing the dirt then four wide into the stretch and lacked needed late punch. OFFLEE WILD BOYS content to lag back early, remained outside winner, was fanned five wide into the stretch and failed to menace from the far outside. DIME was closest pursuer down the hill, continued outside rival, drifted out four wide crossing the dirt and was no late factor.
