Footnotes

JERANIMO angled in and settled off the pace inside then outside a rival leaving the backstretch and on the second turn, came three wide into the stretch, rallied under good handling to gain the lead past midstretch and won clear. TEMPLE'S DOOR saved ground stalking the pace, came out a bit for room in midstretch and went outside the pacesetter late for the place. CHOSEN MIRACLE sped to the early lead, angled in and set the pace inside, dueled into the second turn, inched away again in the stretch, was not a match for the winner in the final furlong and lost second late. JUNIPER PASS saved ground chasing the pace, lacked room off heels in midstretch, came out a bit in deep stretch but could not offer the necessary response. TALE OF A CHAMPION between horses early, chased outside a rival or just off the rail, went alongside a foe on the second turn and between horses into the stretch and did not rally. SLIM SHADEY (GB) pulled early, chased off the rail or outside a rival, went three deep into and on the second turn and into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. FAST TRACK stalked three deep then off the rail, bid alongside the pacesetter leaving the backstretch and on the second turn, was between foes in midstretch and also weakened.
