Footnotes

MAMBO SLEW saved ground stalking the pace, came out leaving the second turn, bid three deep into the stretch, gained the lead and kicked clear under left handed urging and was under steady handling late. TICKER TAPE (GB) in a bit tight into the first turn, chased outside a rival, went three deep on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and finished well for second. YINGYINGING sent between horses early, stalked inside then a bit off the rail, bid outside a foe on the backstretch and second turn, took a short lead into the stretch, drifted in a bit in midstretch and held third. JOHN'S KINDA GIRL angled in and settled inside, came out off heels on the second turn, angled in outside a rival entering the stretch, came out again for room in upper stretch and lacked the needed rally. SHADOW OF MINE saved ground chasing the pace, steadied in tight into the second turn, came out into the stretch, split rivals nearing midstretch then steadied again off heels and could not summon the necessary late kick. STELLAR JAYNE three deep into the first turn, chased outside a rival, steadied between horses on the second turn and weakened. BRAVE VIXEN also went three deep early, stalked outside a rival or off the rail, came out into the stretch and also weakened. SHAKE OFF had speed btwn foes early, angled in on the first turn and inched clear, then set a pressured pace inside but weakened in the drive.
