**Footnotes**

MEET THE HEAT sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, kicked away leaving the second turn, drew clear, lugged inward in the lane and proved best under some left handed urging and good handling. EXCESS THE BEST stalked the winner off the rail and was second best. TESSA TIME chased off the inside, came out some in the stretch and bested the others. THUNDER BEBE angled in and saved ground off the pace, came out leaving the second turn and into the stretch and could not offer the necessary late kick. LEMON FRESH TIDE forced wide into the first turn, angled in and chased outside a rival and did not rally. MOTHER MARIA saved ground chasing the pace, came out into the stretch and lacked a further response. BOUQUET EROSION off a bit in the air then bobbed, stalked the pace inside and weakened in the stretch. OUR ENCORE came off the rail on the first turn, chased outside a rival, came out leaving the second turn and into the stretch and weakened. CRAZY JIG drifted out into the first turn, dropped back off the rail, angled in on the second turn and gave way.
