Footnotes

RECIPIENT grabbed stalking position from along the rail, angled off the rail and moved up on the second turn, loomed outside pacesetter leaving that bend, battled briefly then reached front and edged away under urging. SECRET COVE bobbled leaving the gate but quickly recovered and stepped to the front, dictated fractions along the fence, resisted inside winner in upper stretch then relinquished control and safely held second. YELLOW SLICKER tracked pace from outside the leader into backstretch, continued two then three wide into and around the final turn, came in bit in the lane and drew away from rival for minor award. EZ RACHEL settled slightly off the rail then outside winner, chased three then four wide into the stretch and was outfinished for third. GHOST N YOUR HEART reserved from the inside, continued to hug the rail to the second turn and never menaced late from the inside. EMILY PEARL unhurried while steered to the rail, saved ground to the second turn, gradually shifted back out, swung five wide into the stretch and lacked needed response.
