Footnotes

MARY KIES five wide on the hill, angled in outside a rival, moved up four wide on the second turn and into the stretch, gained a short lead nearing midstretch and held on gamely under urging. HIGH WALDEN pulled her way along early, settled outside a rival, launched a bid three deep between foes into and on the second turn, battled between horses in the stretch and inside the winner late and continued willingly but could not get by. SATIN CAT saved ground in a good position early, came a bit off the rail on the backstretch, went between rivals into and on the second turn, came out into the stretch and bested the rest. LOUVE MYSTERIEUSE four wide on the hill, pulled her way up three deep between foes to duel for the lead, angled in on a short advantage on the second turn, came out into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. SHEBANE pulled along the inside early, came out leaving the backstretch and again on the second turn, entered the stretch four wide and lacked the needed rally. DARE BUNNY six wide on the hill, pulled her way up four wide to contest the pace, was three deep leaving the backstretch, dueling between horses on the second turn then weakened in the lane. CHESHIRE CAT (IRE) between foes early, angled in and dueling inside, dropped back on the second turn and gave way, then did not return to be unsaddled and was vanned off. FILITOSA off the rail early, pulled her way along to force the pace between horses, fell back approaching the second turn, angled in and also gave way.
