Footnotes

PRINTEMPS (CHI) allowed to lag back along the inside, began to advance on the second turn, came out into the stretch and again in upper stretch and closed boldly under some urging, swept to the front a sixteenth out and won clear. RHIANA off a bit slowly, chased just off the rail then outside a rival leaving the backstretch, bid five wide on the second turn and into the stretch, gained a short lead, inched away past midstretch but could not match the winner. ANGEL GIFT angled in and saved ground chasing the leaders, came out leaving the backstretch, bid four wide between horses on the second turn and into the stretch and just held third. SEA REEL angled in and dueled inside, fought back on the second turn and in the stretch but could not match strides with either of the top pair late and just held third. SE ME ACABO (CHI) had good early speed and prompted the pace three deep, battled between horses on the second turn and into the stretch and weakened. CANASITA (GB) three deep into the first turn, chased off the rail, swung wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. TAMARACK BAY vied for command between horses, fought back into the stretch, steadied when squeezed in midstretch and weakened.
