Footnotes

SHE'S THE GENERAL stalked the pace outside, bid three deep on the backstretch, fell back a bit nearing the quarter pole, bid again three wide into the stretch, gained the lead nearing midstretch and inched clear under some urging. ENDURING GRACE broke a bit slowly, settled off the rail, split horses leaving the second turn, came four wide into the stretch and finished well. THE EMSTER stalked the pace a bit off the rail, came out leaving the second turn and into the stretch and was edged for second. RED HAIR LADY stalked the early pace off the rail, bid between horses on the backstretch, battled outside a rival leaving the second turn and between foes again in the stretch but weakened late. IZA LEGEND sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, dueled along the rail on the backstretch and second turn, fought back to midstretch, then weakened in the final furlong. WILD MEETING pulled early and was in a bit tight into the first turn, chased between horses then outside on the second turn, came five wide into the stretch and gave way. ELEMENT K. saved ground stalking the pace, came out into the stretch and had little left. SHARP AS A FOX a bit slow to begin, went up into a good position stalking the pace three deep, dropped back and angled in on the second turn and gave way.
