DIFERENTKINDAGREAT took the early lead just off the rail then angled in, set the pace inside, dueled on the backstretch and second turn, inched away and came out into the stretch, drifted out some then inward past midstretch and held on gamely under urging. NEVER angled in and stalked inside, inched forward leaving the backstretch, continued inside on the second turn, bid along the rail in deep stretch and continued willingly to the wire. ACCLAMATION stalked four wide into the first turn, bid four wide on the backstretch and second turn and into the stretch and saved the show. SNOWMASTER allowed to settle outside a rival, went four wide into and on the second turn and six wide into the stretch and bested the others. STELLA MARK settled off the rail, split horses three deep on the second turn, came out five wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. OLIVER stalked just off the rail then bid between horses on the backstretch and second turn and weakened in the stretch. BRENTHURST stalked between horses then bid three deep between foes to press the pace to the stretch and also weakened. SQUALLCREEK four wide into the first turn, angled in and chased outside a rival then between horses on the second turn, found the rail in the stretch and had little left for the drive.
