GLORIFIED (GB) stalked outside a rival then off the rail, bid alongside the pacesetter leaving the second turn, took the lead into the stretch and drew clear under a crack of the whip and good handling. CAROUSEL (GB) angled in and settled outside a rival then a bit off the rail, came out on the second turn and three deep into the stretch and just got the place. GENIALITY pulled her way along five wide then angled in outside a rival and took the lead on the first turn, set the pace a bit off the rail then inside, dueled leaving the second turn and into the stretch, was no match for the winner in the drive and just lost second. PLATINUM MINE angled in and chased inside then between horses leaving the backstretch and on the second turn, angled in again and waited briefly off heels a quarter mile out, continued inside in the stretch and was edged for the show. DUBAI PERFECTO between horses early, chased outside a rival then off the rail leaving the second turn and lacked the needed rally. WARREN'S HOPEFUL pulled early and steadied then came out off heels into the first turn, chased outside a rival then three deep leaving the backstretch and on the second turn and could not offer the necessary response. GIRLS LACROSSE saved ground chasing the pace, dropped back on the second turn, came out into the stretch and weakened. TIABELLE had speed inside then saved ground stalking the pace, dropped back in a bit tight between horses into the stretch, gave way and was eased in the drive.
