CIRCA sped to the lead and angled in, shook off KENDRA on the second turn and held on gamely under urging. QUALATATIVE, settled outside NO ETAL early, split rivals leaving the second turn and into the stretch and finished well for second. QUEENOFTHEPROM came in at the start, settled three deep, swung five wide into the stretch and gained the show. CAPRICORN MOON was close up between rivals, came out four wide into the stretch and could not offer the needed late response. KENDRA four wide early, angled in on the first turn, bid outside the winner, drifted out into the stretch and weakened. NO ETAL, pulled inside early, came off the rail on the backstretch, split rivals in midstretch and also lacked the necessary late response. MAGIC HILL (GB) angled in nearing the first turn, saved ground to the stretch, came out and weakened. MEDITATIVE chased the leaders three deep to the stretch and also weakened. ROCK N ROLL HEAVEN saved ground close up but dropped back in the stretch. TOUCH OF JADE broke slowly then steadied when squeezed and was outrun.
