DIXIE DOT COM forced or stalked the pace four wide, swept to the front in upper stretch, drew clear while drifting in under left handed urging and drifted out a bit late but proved best. EVENT OF THE YEAR, saved ground toward the inside, inched forward leaving the backstretch, waited momentarily before swinging out five wide into the stretch and finished well but could not match the winner. OLD TOPPER had a rail trip forcing the pace and held the show. RUN MAN RUN pulled his way along and dueled three deep between rivals nearly the whole way to the stretch, then weakened. MAIL COACH (CHI) off a bit slowly, pulled his way along outside on the first turn and early on the backstretch, dropped back on the second turn and weakened. YARROW BRAE squeezed a bit at the start, was in a bit tight between rivals leaving the first turn, settled on the backstretch and lacked a rally. ARTAX dueled between rivals on a short lead, steadied while weakening into the stretch and dropped back. HANUMAN HIGHWAY (IRE) settled off the rail, angled in for the second turn and did not rally.
