WAR CHANT quickly sprinted to the front, rated kindly on a slim lead along the inside, kicked clear while being pushed along some into the stretch and drew off under hand urging, then was taken under a hold late. REBA'S GOLD stalked the pace outside, bid three deep leaving the backstretch and outside the winner on the second turn, then was no match for that one while clearly second best. SMOOTH was well placed inside stalking the pace, had a rail trip and held third. TICKET TO FUN pulled his way along between foes early, chased between horses to the second turn, continued off the rail and did not rally. NATES COLONY off a bit slowly, angled in and saved ground unhurried, came out some into the stretch and improved position. ANSTAR (GB) also off a bit slowly, settled outside a rival, came out into the stretch and failed to menace. INDIANA AFFAIR settled three deep to the second turn, continued outside a foe and did not rally. TIMEQUAKE forced the pace outside the winner to the second turn, dropped back on that bend and gave way.
