Footnotes

SKELLYTOWN a bit slow to begin, pulled four wide into the first turn then stalked three deep, came three wide into the stretch, bid between horses to gain a short lead and held on gamely under urging. CAVANAL chased between horses then outside on the backstretch, moved up four wide on the second turn and into the stretch, bid outside foes in the drive and continued willingly but could not get by the winner. MAJOR GENERAL chased between foes then off the rail on the second turn, came out into the stretch and just got the show. JACK'S WILD broke in and bobbled a bit, angled in and settled a bit off the rail, split horses on the backstretch, angled in leaving the second turn, waited off heels in midstretch then angled in and again and went willingly between foes late. FIRE BREAK four wide into the first turn, stalked outside a rival, came out leaving the second turn, bid between horses into and through the stretch,

drifted in a bit in deep stretch and was outfinished. SOUPY five wide into the first turn, settled outside then alongside a rival, came out into the stretch and also was outfinished. MY MAN MURF between foes early, stalked inside, came out a bit off heels for room in the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. EPIC POWER stalked outside a rival then a bit off the rail, dropped back between horses into the stretch and weakened. EL TROFEO (ARG) sent between horses then pulled a bit, set the pace inside, fought back along the rail in the stretch, was in a bit tight in deep stretch and weakened late. PREMIERE FLYER saved ground off the pace, continued inside on the second turn and into the stretch and did not rally.
