Footnotes

DA RULER dueled inside, fought back when headed in the stretch, regained the advantage past the eighth pole, brushed with the runner-up in deep stretch and gamely prevailed under left handed urging. ALBERGATTI broke in a bit, had speed three deep then dueled outside the winner, put a head in front in upper stretch, fought back in the final furlong while lugging in a bit, brushed with the winner in deep stretch and could not quite match that one late. DOUBLEDOWN ON TEN bumped early, stalked the pace inside, came out a bit into the stretch and clearly bested the others. BRANNIGAN had speed between horses then stalked off the rail, continued alongside a rival leaving the backstretch and into the turn, came out into the stretch and weakened. EASY PLEASE broke slowly, settled just off the rail then inside, saved ground on the turn, remained inside in the stretch and did not rally. ALPENNY a bit crowded at the start, settled off the rail then angled in on the backstretch, came out into the stretch and failed to menace. CELTIC HEIR bumped early, chased off the rail, angled in some on the turn, continued alongside a rival into the stretch, gave way and was eased in the final furlong.
