ALWAYS A PRINCESS was fanned wide into the first turn, stalked off the rail then bid outside a rival and dueled for the lead, took a short advantage a quarter mile out, kicked clear under urging in the stretch, drifted inward in the final furlong and held gamely. BLIND LUCK dropped back along the inside early, saved ground on the first turn, inched forward while tugging her way along the rail on the backstretch, came out on the second turn and three deep into the stretch and finished willingly but could not catch the winner. FASHION TREND chased outside a rival then a bit off the rail on the second turn and edged the pacesetter late for the show. CHAMPAGNE D'ORO had good early speed and came off the rail, drifted out into the first turn, dueled off the inside, angled to the fence on the second turn and fought back leaving that turn but weakened in the stretch. MALIBU PIER settled inside chasing the pace, continued a bit off the rail on the backstretch, angled in again for the second turn but had little left for the stretch.
