Footnotes

EASY GRADES forced the early pace outside a rival then stalked inside, split horses with a bid into the stretch to take command and drew clear under some urging. CHISELLING angled in and saved ground off the pace, came a bit off the rail on the backstretch, launched a bit outside on the second turn and five wide into the stretch and rallied for the place. MISTER G. Q. settled off the rail, moved up three deep on the backstretch, came out off heels leaving the second turn and four wide into the stretch and picked up the show. TOURING ENGLAND stalked the pace outside, bid three deep leaving the second turn and into the stretch but was outfinished. FEBRUARY STORM pulled his way between horses and chased between rivals to the second turn, waited a bit then split foes leaving that bend and lacked the needed rally. METRO saved ground off the pace to the stretch, came out nearing midstretch and improved position. SHIP AHOY sped to the early lead, angled in and dueled inside to the stretch, then weakened. RUN DON'T DANCE unhurried outside a rival to the second turn, swung out four wide into the stretch and failed to menace. SMASHOVER saved ground chasing the pace, came out leaving the second turn and three deep into the stretch and weakened. TELL THEM NOTHING went up three deep on the first turn then pressed the pace outside a rival, was between horses on the second turn, lugged out while weakening leaving that turn and had nothing left.
