### Footnotes

GO FOR COVER stalked the pace inside, came out into the stretch and rallied under some urging to be along in time. SAVVY AND SMOOTH had good early speed and dueled inside, fought back to a short lead along the rail past midstretch, could not match the winner late but was game for second. SOUTHERN GUY broke on top but bobbed slightly and came in a bit, angled in and dueled outside the runner-up, put a head in front in midstretch and was outgamed by that rival for the place. SIGN OF THE FOUR squeezed a bit at the start, was climbing early, settled off the rail, angled in on the turn and bested the others. EMBRACE THE STORM pulled a bit and stalked between rivals, came out into the stretch and weakened. BAD BIG AL also pulled his way between horses to stalk the pace three deep, steadied in tight into the turn, came four wide into the stretch, drifted in some and lacked a further response. HOLD THIS a bit crowded at the start, stalked four wide then three deep on the turn, drifted to the inside in the stretch and weakened. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the run entering the far turn but made no change when they ruled the videotape failed to establish responsibility for the incident.
