FOR FOUR-YEAR-OLDS. By subscription of \$150 each to accompany the nomination. \$1,500 additional to start with \$75,000 guaranteed, and an additional \$75,000 from the Breeders' Cup Fund for Cup nominees only. The host association's money to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 12% to third, 6% to fourth and 2% to fifth. Breeders' Cup fund monies also correspondingly divided provided a Breeders' Cup nominee has finished in an awarded position. Any Breeders' Cup fund monies not awarded will revert to the fund. 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$90,000 twice at one mile or over in 2008-09, allowed 2 lbs.; non-winners of \$90,000 at one mile or over in 2008-09 or \$60,000 at any distance since December 25, 4 lbs.; a race of \$45,000 since July 1, 6 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the owner of the winner. Nominations Closed Thursday, January 8th, 2009 with 25.

Footnotes

NOWNOWNOW angled in and chased inside, moved up along the rail on the second turn, came out in upper stretch, gained the lead under some urging past midstretch and pulled clear. DAKOTA PHONE wide early after a bit of a slow beginning, angled in on the first turn and settled inside, got through along the rail into the stretch and gained the place. WISHFUL TOMCAT angled in and stalked inside, slipped through along the fence to gain the lead into the stretch, inched away, came a bit off the rail in the drive and was outfinished for the place. SLEW'S TIZNOW chased outside then three deep on the backstretch and second turn, came out some in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. CHEROKEE ARTIST settled off the pace inside, came out on the second turn and three deep into the stretch and lacked the necessary late kick. EL GATO MALO chased outside a rival then a bit off the rail, went between foes leaving then three wide on the second turn and into the stretch and could not offer the needed response. MUNY had speed a bit off the rail then set the pace inside, inched away again on the second turn, drifted out into the stretch and weakened. TRES BORRACHOS chased outside then three deep, dropped back into and on the second turn and had little left for the stretch. BOOTED three deep early, stalked outside a rival, bid alongside the leader on the

backstretch, tracked again between foes on the second turn and weakened. SILVER SWORD stalked three deep then outside, dropped back on the second turn and gave way. MADEO off a bit slowly, settled outside a rival, was pulled up on the backstretch and vanned off.
