BRADY BLUE EYES chased outside then alongside a rival, came out into the stretch, rallied under a vigorous hand ride to gain the lead three wide in deep stretch and proved best. JOYFUL SUCCESS stalked outside a rival, bid alongside the pacesetter in the stretch, battled between horses in deep stretch and continued willingly to be second best. DRIVELIKETIGER broke inward, sped to the early lead, angled in on the hill and set the pace inside, came a bit off the rail in the stretch, fought back to deep stretch and held third. MAJESTIC AFLEET was a bit slow to begin then was squeezed back between foes, steadied and had the rider lose an iron briefly, settled just off the rail, came out in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. CAMP VICTORY squeezed a bit at the start, went up inside to stalk the pace, came out into the stretch, angled back to the inside in upper stretch and weakened. DREAM NETTIE broke out and bumped a rival, pulled his way along off the rail and steadied nearing the right hand curve, angled in and stalked inside and lacked a response in the stretch. Rail on hill at 14 feet.
