INDIAN WINTER chased between horses then a bit off the rail, went outside a rival on the turn and three deep into the stretch and rallied under left handed urging to wear down the runner-up in late stretch. CITY COOL had speed between horses then inched away into the turn, angled in and set the pace inside, came a bit off the rail in the stretch, kicked clear and held on well but was worn down late. SINAI broke slightly in the air, was sent between horses then pressed the pace inside, steadied when shuffled back into the turn, remained on the rail in the stretch and was in a bit close off heels at the wire but bested the rest. MR ARTISTIC M D three deep early, chased outside a rival, fell back on the turn, found the inside in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. CLASSIC LEGACY saved ground off the pace, came out into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. ARCADIAN had speed outside the runner-up then prompted the pace three deep, stalked outside a rival on the turn, split horses in midstretch and weakened. INDUSTRY LEADER came out and chased outside a rival on the backstretch, went three deep on the turn and into the stretch, drifted inward in the drive and also weakened.
