KIR settled off the rail then inside on the hill, came out in upper stretch, rallied under some urging and a strong hand ride between horses in the final furlong to gain the lead in deep stretch and held. BROKER BRETT saved ground chasing the pace, came out leaving the hill and into the stretch and also rallied outside horses late. LEFTY O'DOUL stalked inside, came out into the stretch, took the lead alongside a rival, drifted in a bit past the sixteenth pole and was outfinished but held third. JUST FISHIN chased outside a rival then a bit off the rail, angled in on the hill, came out in midstretch and rallied between foes. ODEON allowed to settled just off the inside, came out in the stretch and found his best stride late. DYNAMIZE unhurried a bit off the rail to the stretch, angled to the inside in the drive and lacked the needed rally. EXULTANT sped to the early lead, set the pace a bit off the rail then inside, fought back in the drive, steadied when crowded a bit just past the sixteenth pole and weakened. WORLD RENOWNED stalked off the rail then outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and weakened. Rail on hill at 7 feet.
