Footnotes

WOULD YOU settled a bit off the rail or outside a rival, continued off the inside on the second turn, swung out into the stretch and rallied under some urging with the whip turned down and good handling to gain the lead a sixteenth out and proved best while drifting in some late. BOYETT stalked inside then a bit off the rail, bid between horses to gain the advantage leaving the second turn, inched away in the stretch, could not match the winner in the final sixteenth but was clearly second best. VALTARI pulled some and saved ground chasing the pace, came out into the stretch and again in midstretch and outfinished a rival late for the show. VIBRATO JAZZ stalked just off the rail or outside a rival, bid three deep leaving the second turn and into the stretch, was between horses in midstretch and lost third late. MAXX THE GIANT had speed outside a rival the inched away and angled in, set the pace inside, dueled leaving the second turn and weakened in the stretch. ASHLEY'S BAMBINO stalked three deep then outside a rival, continued three wide on the second turn and into the stretch and lacked a rally in the drive. FLEXIPLUS bobbed slightly just after the start, saved ground off the pace, came out some into the stretch and did not rally.
