SUMMER GLIMMER, off a bit slowly, settled well off the rail, angled in and split rivals on the turn, came out four wide into the stretch and rallied under a couple cracks of the whip to gain the lead in deep stretch, then pulled clear. LUCKY SLEWPTY, four wide early, angled in and dueled outside NAME THAT TUNERUP, put a head in front on the turn, kicked clear but could not hold off the winner. MOANA LOA, hopped slightly in a slow start, angled in and moved up, came out leaving the turn and got the show. DESTINA, outside ANNA LYNN on the backstretch, split rivals on the turn and was outfinished for third. ANNA LYNN saved ground close up, steadied off heels into the stretch, split rivals in deep stretch but could not recover. HALEE settled off the rail, swung out in upper stretch and did not rally. NAME THAT TUNERUP sped between rivals early, angled in and dueled for command to the stretch, then weakened. COCHET COCHET raced four wide to the turn, angled in some leaving the bend and weakened. CHILL'S ROSE, split rivals leaving the backstretch, went three deep on the turn and also weakened.
