ATTEMPTED HUMOR angled in and saved ground chasing the pace, moved up into the stretch and finished gamely under left handed urging to get up late. TRIMARAN between horses early, angled in and set a pressured pace inside, drifted off the fence in the stretch, inched away in deep stretch but was caught nearing the wire. SAFETY ZONE settled off the rail then outside a rival, angled out into the stretch and outfinished a foe late for third. BOOYAH three deep early, forced the pace outside the runner-up, fought back in the stretch and weakened some but just lost the show. FRANK THE BARBER broke in and bobbed slightly, angled in and chased inside, came out some into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. SARTORIAL stalked inside then a bit off the rail, came out on the second turn and three deep into the stretch and weakened.
