MOM NANA PETRIE steadied slightly between horses shortly after the start, saved ground while pulling around the first turn, chased inside a rival on the backstretch, came out leaving the quarter pole, came into the stretch three wide, rallied off the rail through the final furlong and was up for the win in the last jump. LORD KITRA pulled her way to the front and inched away around the first turn, set the pace inside down the backstretch and around the second turn, maintained a clear advantage in midstretch, shortened stride late and was caught on the wire. TIZ ANNA was caught three wide into the first turn, chased outside a rival on the backstretch, moved up to stalk the pacesetter into and around the second turn and weakened on the inside through the final furlong. SHARP BELLA steadied when in tight between horses entering the first turn, chased inside down the backstretch and around the second turn and weakened through the final furlong. PAY THE CUTIE was hustled leaving the gate and showed the way into the first turn, stalked outside then between horses down the backstretch, could not keep pace on the second turn and weakened in the lane. AMY'S CASHIN IN chased the pace outside the winner on the backstretch, remained off the rail on the second turn and did not threaten in the lane.
