Footnotes

SPRING BLOOM stalked the pace a bit off the rail, bid between horses leaving the backstretch, took a short lead into the second turn, inched away into the stretch and held on gamely under left handed urging. MUM'S TRUCKEE a bit slow to pulled hard three deep into and on the first turn, stalked the pace, bid three wide leaving the backstretch and on the second turn and into the stretch, could not match the winner in the final furlong but was clearly second best. PARTY WITH BRANDO had speed outside a rival then inched away and angled in, set the pace inside, fought back along the rail leaving the backstretch and on the second turn, weakened some in the stretch but held third. ALWAYS A CHANCE hopped in a bit of a slow start, pulled her way along inside and was in tight into the first turn, came a bit off the rail on the backstretch, went outside a rival on the second turn, swung three wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. CHIMI DEE tugged her way between horses then chased outside a foe, came three deep into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. TANQUERRY a bit washy in the post parade, had speed inside then saved ground stalking the pace and weakened in the stretch. LIKA broke a bit slowly, came off the rail in the run to the first turn, chased three deep, angled to the inside on the second turn, split horses into the stretch and did not rally.
