GLICK saved ground after the right hand curve, came out leaving the hill and four wide into the stretch, then swept to the front under some hand encouragement past midstretch and won clear under a long hold. SPECIAL RATE chased between horses then off the rail, came outside a rival leaving the hill and three deep into the stretch and picked up the place late. F J'S PACE sped to the early lead then dueled inside, fought back into the stretch and weakened late but held third. GALLANT (GB) a bit slow into stride, settled just off the inside, came out in upper stretch and just missed the show. SHADOW OF ILLINOIS stalked inside, was in a bit tight behind the trees on the hill, steadied off heels leaving the hill, came out in deep stretch and could not offer the necessary response. UNFURL THE FLAG stalked the pace three deep then bid outside the leader leaving the hill, came out a bit into the stretch, dropped back between foes past midstretch and weakened, then was in a bit tight late. RUSTY MAN pulled his way between horses early, steadied at the right hand curve then pressed the pace outside a rival, fell back on the hill, steadied again when trying to lug out on the dirt crossing and gave way. NEW COURSE RECORD. Rail on hill at zero.
