Footnotes

MILLTOWN ROAD angled in and settled outside a rival, went four wide on the second turn and five wide into the stretch and closed willingly under some urging to get up late. POWER SHIFT broke inward, pulled his way along three deep then stalked outside, bid three wide into the stretch, gained the lead past the eighth pole and held on well but was caught between foes late. SILBER chased inside then off the rail, split rivals on the second turn, came four wide into the stretch and rallied between foes. CUT TRAIL close up stalking the pace outside a rival, came out leaving the second turn and clipped heels into the stretch, then finished with interest between horses. OPA prompted the pace between foes then outside a rival, continued between horses into the stretch, put a head in front nearing midstretch and was outfinished. LAINIES LION chased inside, was shuffled back leaving the second turn, went around a rival in deep stretch and was trying to come back inside foes. DR. SINATRA stalked the pace inside, came out a bit in the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. EPIC DEVIL had speed outside a rival then angle in and set the pace inside, inched away briefly on the backstretch, battled inside on the second turn and into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. A claim of foul by the rider of CUT TRAIL against the runner-up for alleged interference leaving the second turn was not allowed by the stewards, who ruled the videotape was inconclusive.
