MS. G. I. JANE chased outside then three deep, continued alongside a rival leaving the hill, came three wide into the stretch, rallied to the front under some late urging in deep stretch and won clear. WOEBEGON had good early speed and stalked just off the rail, bid alongside the pacesetter to gain the advantage in the stretch, fought back between foes in deep stretch and held second. THE GANG AND I stalked three wide then outside a rival, split horses in midstretch and edged foes for third between horses late. THREE CUTIES settled a bit off the rail then outside a rival, came between horses into the stretch, angled out in the drive and put in a late bid four wide on the wire. PROMISCUOUSSUANCES sped to the early lead, set the pace off the rail then inside, fought back when challenged in the stretch and weakened late. FOUR BETTER (GB) saved ground chasing the pace, came out in the stretch, split rivals in midstretch and lacked the needed rally. ZEES CHRIS stalked a bit off the rail then inside, continued along the fence in the stretch and could not

summon the necessary response. MISS REDITORE a bit slow to begin, chased between horses then inside leaving the hill, came out in upper stretch and also lacked the needed late kick between foes late. NO TRICKS FOR JACK chased outside then three deep on the hill, came four wide into the stretch and did not rally. SECRET GENIUS broke a bit slowly, saved ground off the pace to the stretch and was not a threat. RUFFLED FEATHERS bobbed slightly at the start, settled outside then alongside a rival on the hill and failed to menace. CHA CHA LATTE chased off the rail then inside, came out leaving the hill and three wide into the stretch and weakened. Rail on hill at 7 feet.
