Footnotes

SPELLBOUND allowed to settle off the rail, came out leaving the second turn and four wide into the stretch and rallied under urging to get up four wide on the wire. LET FAITH ARISE came off the rail nearing the first turn to chase the pace, continued outside a rival on the backstretch and just off the fence on the second turn, angled out into the stretch, drifted in a bit in the drive but rallied between foes late. ONDINE bumped at the start, had speed inside then stalked a bit off the rail, bid alongside the pacesetter into and on the second turn, took the lead into the stretch, inched away in midstretch, fought back toward the inside in the final furlong and continued willingly to the wire. FIFTYSHADESOFHAY steadied when squeezed at the start, chased outside a rival or off the rail, split horses on the second turn, came out into the stretch and finished willingly between foes late. BROKEN SWORD broke in onto foes, had speed outside a rival then kicked clear and angled in, set the pace inside, dueled along the rail on the second turn and into the stretch, then weakened. RATHBAUN chased three deep or outside a rival, continued three wide early on the second turn, fell back and angled in some leaving that turn and also weakened. OSCAR PARTY steadied when squeezed at the start, saved ground chasing the pace, dropped back on the second turn and gave way.
