Footnotes

VICTORY ROAR climbing and angled to the inside early, chased the leaders on the backstretch, was a bit crowded midway on the turn, continued a bit off the rail, came out into the stretch and rallied under urging to get up late. OLYMPIC LIGHT forced the early pace outside a rival then stalked that one off the rail, rallied to a slim advantage between horses nearing the wire but was caught late. SLEWDARIO had good early speed and duelled inside a rival, set the pace a bit off the rail, remained clear in deep stretch but weakened late and was caught nearing the wire. FLEETSTREET DANCER broke in and steadied a bit, settled outside chasing the pace, came five wide into the stretch and put in a late bid outside. SO URGENT bobbed at the start, angled in and stalked outside or off the rail on the backstretch, found the rail for the turn, bid inside in the stretch but was outfinished. ARMED 'N CRAFTY sent inside to chase the leaders, came out in upper stretch and also found his best stride late. TONYRONY bobbed at the start but broke on top, chased outside on the backstretch and three deep on the turn and lacked the needed rally. MACABE squeezed at the start, went between horses early then outside a rival, angled in on the turn, weakened, and returned bleeding from the nostrils. A. J.'S BAND allowed to settle outside on the backstretch and four wide on the turn, did not rally. BARRON H off a bit slowly, raced just off the inside when unhurried early and was outrun. CISCO'S KITE chased between horses early, dropped back on the backstretch, continued off the rail and weakened. SKIP TO THE STONE broke into the side of the gate and bobbed at the start, raced off the inside and was always outrun.
