Footnotes

BOB AND JOHN stalked three deep then bid outside the runner-up on the backstretch, put a head in front on the second turn, inched away into the stretch and drew clear under a steady hand ride. THE FIVE J'S had speed three deep early, dueled outside a rival then inside the winner, was no match for that one in the stretch and just held second. SACRED LIGHT unhurried along the inside early, came out on the second turn and three deep into the stretch and closed willingly to just miss the place. OLD THUNDER pulled his way along four wide into the first turn, stalked three deep then outside a rival on the second turn and did not rally. SENSATIONAL SCORE chased between horses then inside on the second turn, came out in the stretch and lacked a further response. CHADLINGTON (IRE) allowed to settle off the rail, went outside a rival on the second turn and was not a threat. SWISS SONATA had good early speed and dueled inside, stalked along the rail on the backstretch, dropped back on the second turn and gave way.
