SKINNY GENES content to chase from off the rail into second bend, advanced four wide on that turn then five wide into the stretch, came in slightly under strong handling, rallied to collar leader and win the bob on the wire. WE ARE ONE prompted the pace outside leader to second turn, challenged alongside that rival, gained slim advantage in upper stretch, battled outside same rival past sixteenth marker, edged away but could not stave off the winner. VIKKILEE hugged the rail while trailing early, angled off the fence, came four wide into the stretch, shifted out further in the drive, rallied strongly up and got up for share of the show. LISA LULU was sent to the front and dictated the fractions from the inside, lost lead exiting the last turn, continued to battle gamely inside rival to deep stretch before yielding ground and was caught for piece of third. SHESKEY stalked pace from along the rail to second turn, came out slightly entering the lane, loomed between rivals in the drive, in tight and checked momentarily past sixteenth marker and continued willingly. QUIET ADVICE hugged the rail chasing the leaders, remained along the fence into and through the stretch but failed to seriously menace. LAKES AND FLOWERS stalked from between horses then three wide on the final turn, moved up bit from between rivals in the drive but lacked needed late punch. NOTHING TO FEAR settled well off the rail, raced three wide most of the way into the stretch and weakened.
