Footnotes

GRAMMY TIMES SIX had speed off the rail then dueled outside a rival, inched away into the turn, drifted out a bit into the stretch, fought back when headed, drifted in late but gamely prevailed under urging. YESTERDAY SINGS stalked off the rail then outside a rival, bid alongside the winner into the stretch, put a head in front nearing midstretch but was outgamed late. LOVELY INSTINCT bobbled at the start, chased between horses then a bit off the rail on the turn, found the inside in the stretch and picked up the show. FILLI VANILLI broke a bit slowly, settled off the rail then outside on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and improved position. PERCHED settled a bit off the rail, went outside a rival on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and was not a threat. KATY'S PLUM stalked three deep then outside a rival, continued outside on the turn, drifted seven wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response. SINGLEINTHELAST wide between foes early, stalked outside then three and four wide on the turn and into the stretch and weakened. WARREN'S SUSIE Q. wide early, chased off the rail angled in on the turn and did not rally. I DIG ELLE saved ground chasing the pace, came out leaving

the turn and into the stretch and did not rally. MEAN EMMA JEAN had speed between horses then stalked a bit off the rail, angled in and fell back on the turn and weakened. NOTONTHEFIRSTDATE also had speed between runners then pressed the pace inside, stalked along the rail into and on the turn and also weakened. WARRENS GOLDNUGGET broke slowly, settled outside then off the rail, angled in approaching the turn and was not a threat.
