Footnotes

LADY CADET hopped at the start, saved ground down the hill, swung out on the dirt and five wide into the stretch, bid four wide in midstretch and gamely prevailed late under urging. IMPERFECT WORLD forced the early pace three deep then stalked outside a rival down the hill, took a short lead into the stretch, battled between horses in midstretch and continued gamely to the wire to just miss. TYCOON'S DOLCE (IRE) settled between horses early, angled in down the hill, came out into the stretch and found her best stride late. AVIATE stalked the pace a bit off the rail to the stretch, lacked room behind horses in midstretch, then split foes late. VIGNETTE settled three deep down the hill, came four wide into the stretch, bid three deep between foes in midstretch but was outfinished. WHAT'S THE FUSS sped to the early lead between foes, inched away down the hill, fought back inside in midstretch and weakened late. BOUNTIFUL DREAMER saved ground unhurried to the stretch, came out in upper stretch and lacked the needed response. DEBIT ACCOUNT sent inside to prompt the pace down the hill, remained inside and was in a bit tight when trying to get out nearing the dirt and weakened in the stretch.
