Footnotes

MILLENNIUM WIND settled off the rail tracking the leader, moved up three deep with a bid on the second turn, took the lead into the stretch and gamely prevailed under some urging and good handling. PALMEIRO stalked the pace off the rail, bid outside the leader on the second turn, dueled between horses into the stretch, then fought back inside the winner to the wire but could not quite match that one. DENIED angled in a bit off the rail on the first turn, chased just off the inside, came out leaving the second turn and into the stretch and picked up the show. COKE'S TRIBUTE sped to the early lead, set the pace along the inside, dueled along the rail on the second turn but weakened in the stretch. TURNBERRY ISLE (IRE) chased outside a rival on the first turn and backstretch, continued off the inside, angled in a bit leaving the second turn and also weakened. INDY LEAD without early speed along the inside, came off the rail on the backstretch, was put to urging approaching the second turn but lacked a response.
