

Footnotes

THE SEVEN SEAS off a bit slowly, saved ground unhurried, came out between foes on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and closed willingly under some urging to prove best. PERFECT COPY settled outside, moved up outside on the second turn and four wide into the stretch, gained a short lead past the eighth pole but not hold off the winner while best of the rest. EL SUENO off a bit slowly, angled in and saved ground outrun, came out on the second turn, swung four wide into the stretch and rallied for the show. DESDEMONA (IRE) pulled between horses early, moved up inside leaving the backstretch, swung out into the stretch, could not match the top pair and was edged for third. PALINISA (FR) stalked the pace along the inside, bid outside the pacesetter and dueled on the second turn, gained a short lead, fought back in midstretch but weakened late. ARES VALLIS (IRE) off a bit slowly, was unhurried outside, came four wide into the stretch and improved position. CHESHIRE CAT (IRE) saved ground throughout to no avail. SILVER WHALE (FR) was in a good position outside a rival early, went between foes into and on the second turn but lacked the needed rally. LA VUELTA went up outside to prompt the early pace, chased outside a rival, dropped back on the second turn and weakened. NO ETAL unhurried off the rail early, angled in on the

backstretch and failed to menace. ASHCREEK took the early lead and angled in, set the pace inside, dueled inside on the second turn but weakened in the stretch. BELLE OF HUMBOLDT forced the early pace outside then stalked the pacesetter off the rail, dropped back three deep into the second turn, came wider into the stretch and gave way.
