ROYAL IMPORT (GB) four wide early, chased off the rail, came out leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch, rallied under left handed urging to the lead a sixteenth out and gamely prevailed. WARREN'S GRIDLOCK pulled early, stalked off the rail or outside a rival, bid four wide leaving the second turn, took the lead three deep into the stretch, inched away, fought back inside the winner in deep stretch and continued willingly. ANGA settled inside then off the rail, went around a rival on the second turn, waited off heels briefly then came out for room in midstretch and picked up the show. GOBBLER'S KNOB unhurried and angled in early, came off the inside on the backstretch, swung four wide into the stretch and improved position. FREE BEER chased outside then alongside a rival, continued off the rail on the second turn, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. SOUTHERN VICTORY pulled inside to press the early pace then steadied on the first turn, came out and bid three deep on the backstretch and second turn, was shuffled back a bit between foes into the stretch and weakened. CANDY FOR PASEANA dueled three deep then outside a rival, battled between foes on the backstretch and second turn and weakened in the stretch. BOSTON BAKED BEAN saved ground stalking the pace, came out into the stretch and also weakened. LOOKING FOR CANDY dueled between horses then inside leaving the first turn, battled along the rail on the backstretch and second turn and weakened in the drive. A BIG TO'DO four wide early, trailed off the rail to the stretch and failed to menace.
