Footnotes

CHA CHA LATTE hopped in the air at the start and was off behind her field, chased on the inside,angled off the rail approaching the quarter pole, came into the lane four wide, took over the lead five deep in midstretch and proved best while well off the rail. BEAUTIFUL STRIKE stalked the dueling leaders on the outside down the backstretch and around the turn, came into the lane three wide, was caught four deep in midstretch, went willingly to the wire but had to settle for second best. TASTY TREAT chased a bit off the rail down the backstretch, angled over to save ground around the turn, slipped through on the inside in upper stretch, went willingly to the wire and held the show. ONE MAGICAL GIRL was hustled out of the gate to go up and duel inside for the lead, continued to battle to the lane and weakened between horses through the final furlong. HELP ME HANNAH sped to the early lead and dueled on the outside down the backstretch and around the turn, battled three deep in midstretch and weakened in the final furlong between foes. SILVER STREET chased on the outside down the backstretch and around the turn, remained off the rail in the lane and failed to mount a rally.
