Footnotes

SHE'S VERY RARE tracked pacesetter into the bend, moved up briskly then surged past that foe on the turn, quickly cleared and padded final margin under couple right hand taps and hand urging. LUTESS broke well then settled well off the pace, chased inside, shifted out and circled rivals four wide around the turn and kicked clear to prove second best. GOOD ACKTRESS stalked from the inside then between horses, continued between and three wide around the bend and drew off from others. MUSICAL GRACE bobbled slightly leaving the gate then was squeezed in opening strides, taken to the rail, chased inside then slightly off the rail, was crowded behind rivals leaving the turn and lacked any rally. PIVOTAL QUEEN (IRE) in no hurry early, trailed from slightly off the fence then raced three wide around the turn and was outrun. KAHLUA MIST stalked from off the rail then caught three abreast around the turn, came out further in upper stretch and weakened. TERRIFY quickly stepped to the front, set early pace from the inside, was overtaken on the turn and gave way from along the rail.
