Footnotes

A LITTLE HOT SAUCE was bit antsy in the gate, settled off the leaders, angled out on the backstretch, made steady progress three then four wide into the stretch, closed determinedly from the outside and won bob on the wire. ASHLEY'S BAMBINO conceded lead to rival on the first turn, tracked pace on three wide path, moved up and challenged outside foe leaving the last turn, forged to the front, inched away then drifted out slightly and lost narrow decision on the wire. ALL DE VICTORS saved ground chasing the pace then was inside the eventual winner into second bend, came out bit entering the stretch then rallied strongly from the inside and finished willingly inside top pair. SILVER DRAGON shifted over the tracked leaders from the inside then between horses, regained rail in upper stretch, lacked room along the rail in mid stretch, steadied then came out and did not threaten late. LETHAL INTENT angled over then moved up between horses and forced the pace, bid alongside leader on the last turn, gained brief lead, resisted some inside then yielded in final sixteenth. ST. JOEL also saved ground chasing the pace, shifted out some in upper stretch but never reached contention. SWEET ELATION reserved early from the inside, later came out on the second turn and lacked needed response. ST. VALENTINO broke bit awkwardly but still alertly, raced to clear lead into backstretch, lost command early on second turn and gave way.
