Footnotes

PORFIDO (CHI) content to settle off the pace, chased outside foe and two wide, swung out second turn, came four wide into the stretch, surged between rivals,rushed to the front passing sixteenth marker and safely held under urging. GLOBAL STAGE saved ground chasing the pace, angled out in upper stretch, split rivals through the drive and found best stride late in deep stretch. DOUBLE SHUFFLE unhurried while caught three abreast into the first turn, remained off the rail, caught five wide leaving the last turn, then rallied from between horses and was up gamely for third. SIR BELL bumped at the break, stalked from the inside to the stretch, came out slightly and yielded ground grudgingly in deep stretch. COLUDA was sent to the front, dictated the fractions from the inside, resisted from along the rail into the stretch, battled past eighth marker and lost placing in final yards. EL MERITO (CHI) stalked from off the rail, remained three wide to second turn, angled six wide entering the stretch and went willingly to the wire. DRESS CODE forced the pace to the second

turn, challenged alongside pacesetter leaving that bend, dueled past mid stretch but weakened bit in deep stretch. THEY CALL HIM EL saved ground chasing the leaders, remained inside into the stretch, was blocked behind rivals past eighth marker and failed to threaten late. YODELEN DAN lagged back early while angling over, chased on two wide path into the stretch and lacked any late response. VIOLON SACRE bumped from both sides leaving the gate, stalked while outside foe then between horses and weakened in the final furlong. FANTASTIC PICK (GB) bumped leaving the gate, tracked the pace on three wide path, continued off the rail into the lane and also weakened.
