STORMY MONDAY sped to the early lead and dueled inside, inched away on the backstretch, maintained the advantage into the stretch while coming out some and gamely prevailed. SWISS COURTS CHEAT settled outside, ranged up four wide leaving the turn and into the stretch to loom a threat but could not catch the winner and just held second. RHIANA broke out and was steadied, saved ground off the pace, came out on the turn and again into the stretch and finished well. NAUTICAL LOOK was allowed to settle outside after being wide early, angled in some and raced three deep on the turn, then split rivals late to just miss a minor award. DUE AT DAWN dueled three deep early then stalked the pace off the rail to the stretch and weakened. CRAFTIQUE was close up four wide early, angled in for the turn, split rivals on the bend, found the rail and also weakened. PETITE CAFE steadied in an awkward start, settled off the rail, split rivals on the turn and lacked the needed late response. NICOLE settled a bit off the rail, dropped back outside a rival on the turn and gave way. GLORY ROAD vied for command between foes early and was briefly in a bit tight, dropped back and angled in leaving the backstretch, steadied nearing the quarter pole and gave way readily.
