Footnotes

MARK OF A WARRIOR angled over after the start, dueled outside CYNICAL WAGER in the early stages then between horses , was inside SWONGS on the turn, battled down the lane on the inside and held on while coming out slightly in the final yards. ELUSIVE MOMENT chased off the rail down the backstretch, came into the lane three wide, rallied outside MARK OF A WARRIOR in the final furlong, was floated out slightly nearing the wire and just missed while a clear second at the wire. BERTRAN HILL chased on the inside down the backstretch, was rank and steadied slightly behind CYNICAL WAGER entering the turn, came into the lane four wide and was no match for the top two in the final furlong. SWONGS moved up on the outside to stalk the pace three deep on the backstretch, dueled outside the winner on the turn, came into the stretch between horses and weakened between foes in the final furlong. MR. SATURDAYNIGHT was slow into stride, chased off the rail down the backstretch and around the turn, swung out for the drive and could not muster a rally. CYNICAL WAGER dueled inside the winner down the backstretch, fell back on the inside entering the turn and weakened in the stretch drive.
